The gardeners of Greenhill will be opening their gardens for members of the public to visit. This year 19 gardens of many different shapes, sizes, and styles are open for you to enjoy and wander through.

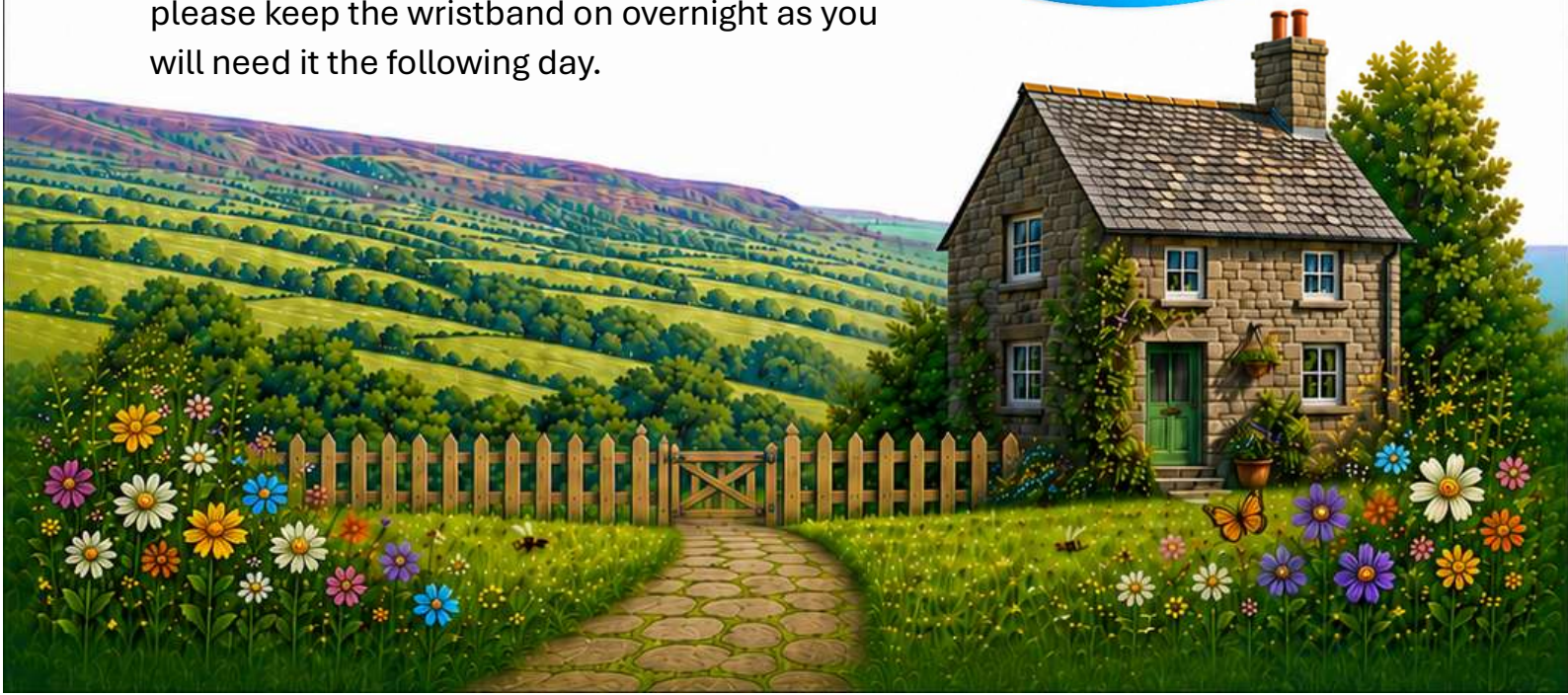
Admission to the gardens is £5 per adult (18 and over).

Children and young adults attending as part of a family are free.

All ticket money goes to support the library. All gardens are within walking distance of the Greenhill library.

Call in at the library and buy wristbands before the event, or from our stall outside the library on the day of the event. You can also buy wristbands from the host of the first garden you visit.

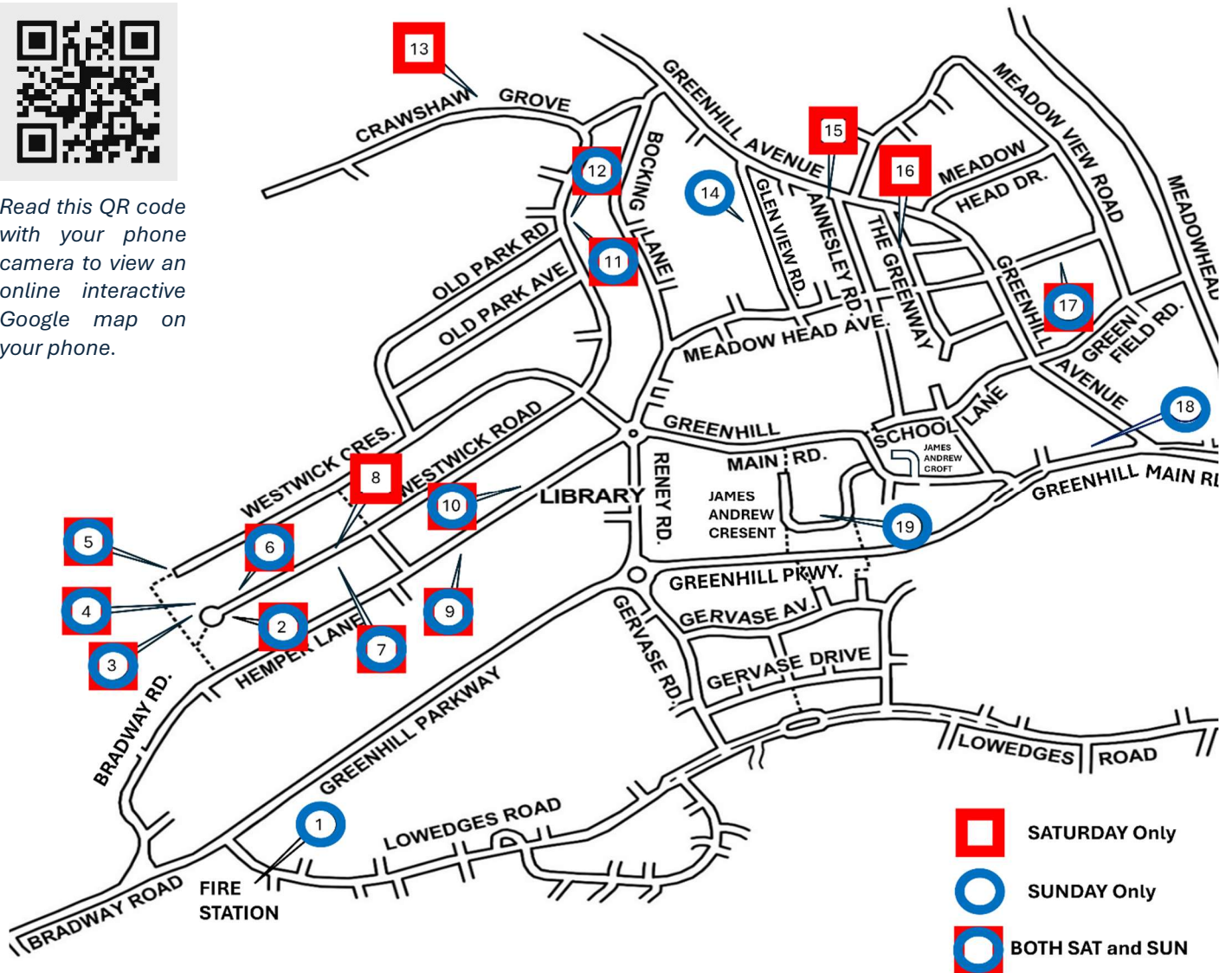
Your wristband is your admission ticket, and you must wear it when you visit the gardens. If you plan on visiting both Saturday and Sunday, please keep the wristband on overnight as you will need it the following day.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Garden no. 5 on Westwick Crescent is **best accessed via the ginnel** at the end of Westwick Road (see map).
2. Gardens no. 11, 12, and 13 are **down a fairly steep hill** which may be difficult to access for those who are challenged walking up and down slopes. Plan ahead.
3. **Some gardens may have hazards** such as steps, uneven paving or unfenced ponds. Please take care when visiting. Look at descriptions for more details.
4. **Many garden plants are not safe to eat, and some may be poisonous.** Visitors are kindly asked not to pick or consume flowers, berries, fruits, leaves, or seeds unless clearly invited to do so by the garden owner. Please supervise children carefully.
5. **Many of the gardeners will be providing refreshments** and some are selling plants and/or seeds. See the garden descriptions overleaf for details. Host gardeners selling plants or refreshments are donating the proceeds to the library or to another charity of their choice.
6. **Not all gardens are open on both days.** Please plan your route ahead of time so that you are only visiting gardens open on the day of your visit. A **red square** indicates gardens open on Saturday, and a **blue circle** indicates open on Sunday.

GARDEN DESCRIPTIONS

- 1 **Lowedges Community Garden. Lowedges Fire Station. Lowedges Rd.** Our revitalised community garden has 8 raised vegetable and fruit beds, a polytunnel, fruit trees and bushes. Its a place for our community to garden, sit, talk and enjoy. Community group meets Monday afternoons and is Open to All.
Sun Only.

- 2 **265 Westwick Road.** Enjoy the lawn, trees, shrubs, flower borders, small veg patch, waterfall and patio. There are several seating areas in the garden. Downstairs toilet available. Wheelchair access limited to the upper patio.
Both Sat and Sun. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 3 **230 Westwick Road.** Well-stocked large enclosed garden with wildlife pond. Patio with potted plants. Step free access and plenty of seating. Activity for children. Refreshments for sale in aid of the Greenhill Library.
Both Sat and Sun. Refreshments Available.

- 4 **228 Westwick Road.** Large enclosed dog-friendly garden. Interesting garden with large deck, cascade and bridge, raised beds, small greenhouse, lovely views. Plants & refreshments for sale in aid of the Greenhill Library.
Both Sat and Sun. Refreshments Available. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 5 **162 Westwick Crescent.** A large and varied mature garden in three tiers. Vegetable beds, fruit trees and a cottage style border; rockery, lawn and borders; a fernery, woodland, pond and a wilder area. There is a large patio with chairs which provide good views over the garden if you don't fancy the steep paths or steps between levels. Ground floor toilet available.
Both Sat and Sun. Refreshments Available. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 6 **222 Westwick Rd..** Enjoy a lovely recently renovated garden with a wonderful view across the valley. Ideas for further development welcome.
Both Sat and Sun.

- 7 **223 Westwick Rd, Sheffield S8 7BY.** Wildlife friendly garden with small meadow area and several small ponds. A large raised pond with pagoda for fish. Colourful borders and tubs. Use of rainwater to sustain ponds and planting as well as a small greenhouse with aquaponic system. Vegetables are planted amongst flowers and shrubs.
Both Sat and Sun. Not Wheelchair Accessible.

- 8 **182 Westwick Road, S8 7BZ.** Informal, mature garden with a mind to bio-diversity (ie not particularly tidy!) Includes pond with waterfall and seating areas.
Sat Only. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 9 **104 Hemper Lane.** A whimsical garden loved by kids and young at heart. Some fruits trees but mostly a flower garden with small fish pond and wishing well.
Both Sat and Sun. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 10 **137a Hemper Lane.** Japanese influenced garden with low steps towards the rear of the garden. An enthusiastic gardener's garden packed with eclectic colours and interesting plants, many in designer pots. Topiary, Bonzai collection, potting shed, and greenhouse. Seeds for sale.
Both Sat and Sun. No Dogs Please. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 11 **49 Westwick Rd.** Front garden: gravel with small acer and plants. Back garden: flax garden, lawn and flower borders, water feature, greenhouse. Books for sale.
Both Sat and Sun. Refreshments Available. No Dogs Please.

- 12 **47 Westwick Rd.** Established over 50 years ago on what was flooded and boggy ground, this garden now spans two levels and showcases a diverse collection of plants, blending the height of palm trees with the classic beauty of camellias, roses, clematis, and hostas. Plenty of seating to relax and enjoy a refreshing cold drink.
Both Sat and Sun. Refreshments Available. No Dogs Please. Not Wheelchair Accessible.

- 13 **36 Crawshaw Grove S8 7EB.** A plant-lovers garden with unusual perennials, annuals, fruit, vegetables and cuttings border. Successful tomato growing and composting. Refreshments and plants for sale. Small pond. Some unevenness to the lawn, so stay to the paths.
Sat Only. Refreshments Available. Not Wheelchair Accessible.

- 14 **18 Glen View Rd, Greenhill S8 7SF.** Generous, westerly facing garden. Designed, created using organic principles to encourage biodiversity, with places to sit in sun or shade. Twenty medium trees planted together with wide range of shrubs and climbers in herbaceous borders. Greenhouse, potting shed and mini-allotment style raised beds for fruit and vegetables. Pebble and shale paths. Four steps upon entry and small changes in level throughout the garden. No dogs please.
Sun Only. No Dogs Please. Not Wheelchair Accessible.

- 15 **72 Greenhill Ave, S8 7TD.** Beautiful garden with many upcycled items to create interesting zones and features. The centre of the garden is four rectangular beds -- one for each season's plants -- with grass strips separating each section for easy maintenance.
Sat Only. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 16 **18 The Greenway S8 7RY.** Gardening on benefits, with recycling, repurposing and creative use of wildlife/ pondlife-friendly spaces, back and front. Features include rockery, stumpery, composting, spiral bed and veg. all designed to delight the senses.
Sat Only. Partly Wheelchair Accessible.

- 17 **9 Meadow Head Ave, S8 7RT.** A stunning NGS garden packed with plants. A surprising 1/3 acre cottage style garden, packed with plants by a true plantswoman. A large variety of unusual plants set in differently planted sections to provide all-year interest. Auricula theatre, patio, gazebo and greenhouse. Miniature log cabin with living roof and cobbled area with unusual plants in pots. Sempervivum, alpine displays and a wildlife 'hotel'.

- 18 **125 Greenhill Main Road.** Aiming to create a garden that can be managed by gently pottering about, featuring raised flower beds with a variety of plants that don't need too much thought. With vegetables and hanging baskets. The owner describes this garden as, "a sitting down with a good book and a large G&T easy Sunday afternoon garden!"

- 19 **30 James Andrew Crescent, Greenhill.** Wildlife friendly garden originally part of the old Greenhill Village crofts. Mature trees, shrubs and floral borders. Caution: some uneven paths and steps, overhanging branches and a small pond.
